Students and Communities are Calling: An Engaged Faculty Institute **2011 Participant Application**

Program Description

The Engaged Faculty Institute (EFI) training program provides an opportunity for up to 20 faculty and instructors to engage in dialogue about student-centered, experiential education that enhances classroom learning while addressing community needs. The seminar series is designed to introduce and provide best practices for service-learning and guide participants as they integrate it into their classroom curriculum and pedagogy. Foundational information on service-learning will be provided through discussion, reading, and guest speakers. Participants will develop or modify a syllabus for one (or more) of their courses in a way that integrates principles and best practices of service-learning. Faculty from Johnson & Wales University; Metropolitan State College of Denver; University of Colorado at Boulder; and University of Colorado, Denver will be selected to join the 2011 cohort.

Participants commit to attend all six training sessions, build service-learning partnerships, and integrate tools and methods into at least one course within one academic year, with the intention of ultimately engaging students in the community while enhancing their classroom learning. The *2011 Engaged Faculty Institute* will consist of a six-week training program in which participants meet Fridays on the Auraria Campus from 12:30 to 2:30 PM beginning January 28 and concluding March 4, 2011.

Application deadline is 5:00 PM on Friday, November, 5th, 2010.
